

Programs available for the MathCOUNTS Scholarship

The University of North Dakota (UND) has the following undergraduate engineering programs:

1. Civil Engineering (BSCE)
2. Mechanical Engineering (BSME)
3. Geological Engineering (BSGeoE)
4. Electrical Engineering (BSEE)
5. Chemical Engineering (BSChE).

All are available on-campus and via online delivery methods (except the BSGeoE).

The UND is also in the process of establishing a Petroleum Engineering (BSPE) degree program.

UND Graduate Programs in Engineering:

1. Master of Science and Master of Engineering degree programs in Civil, Mechanical, Geological, Electrical, and Chemical Engineering,
2. Ph.D. in Chemical Engineering, and
3. Ph.D. in Engineering with specialization in Civil, Mechanical, Geological, Electrical, Chemical, and Energy Engineering.
